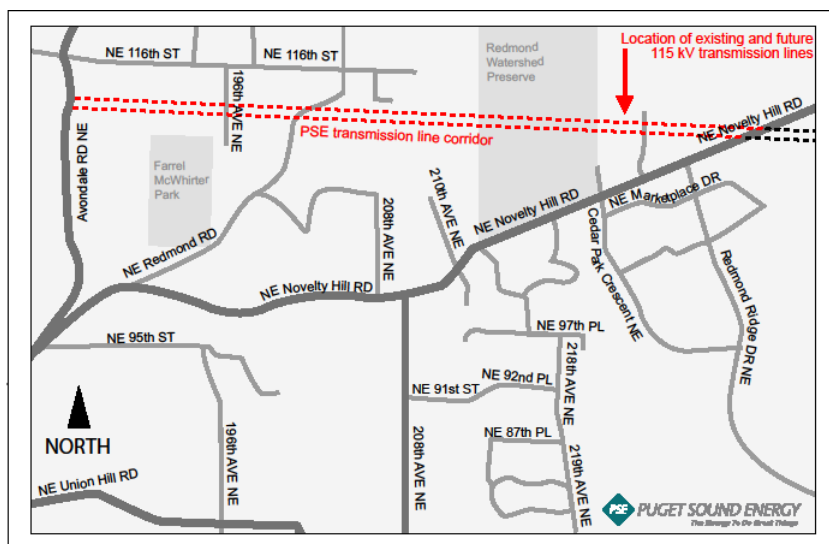

Puget Sound Energy to build a transmission line in the Novelty Hill area of unincorporated King County

Dear Resident or Business Owner,

Puget Sound Energy is working to upgrade our electric system to increase reliability and meet increasing demand for electricity in the city of Redmond and east King County.

Beginning in early May, PSE's contractor will start construction of our new 115 kilovolt transmission line within our existing utility corridor between Northeast Novelty Hill Road and Avondale Road Northeast. The new line will parallel our existing 230 kV transmission line that runs through the utility corridor. Construction will include clearing of the right-of-way, installing new wood poles and wire, and restoration and mitigation work.



The work is expected to take place **Mondays through Fridays from approximately 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Saturdays from approximately 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.** Some select activities, however, may take place after 7 p.m. or 6 p.m. on Saturdays. Construction of the new transmission line is expected to be completed by October 2010, with restoration and mitigation work expected to continue through the end of the year. The work should not disrupt your electric service, or interfere with traffic or other normal activities in the area.
